## Dear Parents,

Since our school has just received a notification from a parent in Room 1 that the building where she lives undergoes compulsory testing. She received a deep throat saliva testing yesterday and now she just has received a message from the Department of Health, being informed of her test result was positive as well as her positive result from Rapid Antigen Test by herself at home. Her daughter has gone back to school these days and has been taken home by parents.

Since that parent's daughter is in the same classroom as the child whose family members were diagnosed yesterday, we are worried that other children may also be infected due to close contact with each other. Therefore, the originally planned arrangement of Flag-raising Ceremony at main gate and National Education Day activities on National Day Eve will be changed to a simple way. The details are revised as follows. Please read it in details and make cooperation.

- 1. The Flag-raising Ceremony will start at 9:05a.m. as usual. All children and teachers will wear Chinese clothes as planned and arrive at school before 8:45a.m. Later, teaching staff will lead them to participate in the ceremony and National Education Day activities through video in the classroom.
- 2. The three Flag-Guards members of K3 class in charge of raising the flag will be arranged to raise the flag at the hall. The "Speech under the National Flag" will be hosted by our Shan Yat Tong Kindergarten Joint school supervisor, Mr. Kwan. The performances by K2 and K3 students and drumming performances by parents will also be presented through online Zoom for all students in class and other parents at home.
- 3. In order to prevent a number of K1 parents gathering in class and walking around, which may cause the opportunity to bring bacteria into our school, the original arrangement for K1 parents to engage in class activities will be cancelled. We apologize for any inconvenience caused.
