Announcement of Rescheduling “National Security Education Day” Event

12th April, 2023

Dear Parents,

Up to 5:00p.m. on 4/4(Tue), we conducted a preliminary interview with all parents for the “National Security Education Day” event to be held at our school in the morning on 15/4(Sat). According to the results reported by class teachers, only 37 parents signed up for it. The main reason for the low participation rate of the activity is believed to be related to the public holidays and school holidays of Easter. As we know, some parents have accompanied children to return to hometowns for visiting relatives or travelling to other areas. Partial parents have to go to work on Saturdays so they are not available to come along with children. There are also some students who regularly participate in interesting classes on Saturdays and cannot reschedule their classes. Due to the above reasons, the number of participants is relatively low.

Since the event is funded by the Quality Education Fund, in terms of cost-effectiveness, the more students benefited, the effectiveness is better. Therefore, we and a collaborator Zhong Guo Fa Lu Yan Jiu Zhong Xin can collect data for analysis after providing services. Unfortunately, the number of participants has not yet reached the expected target. As this activity is very educational, in order to make good use of precious resources, we have consulted with the collaborator and teaching staff at all levels. In the end, we have reached a consensus and decided to renew the original plan, which the “National Security Education Day” will be changed into “National Security Education Week” and the event will be postponed from 17/4(Mon) to 28/4(Fri) during regular school days for students. The collaborator will arrange staff to come to our school to explain to the students the materials

that have been prepared for the exhibition on 15/4(Sat) and carry out related activities. At the same time, the class teachers will cultivate children's good moral character during story-telling time. Such rearrangement is completely cost-effective and achieves the expected aim. It is a pity that parents cannot join together but thank you for your understanding with the aid of collaborator as well.

Although we are unable to hold the “National Security Education Day” event for your children on 15/4(Sat) on campus, the 18 Districts Office in Hong Kong and various regional organizations will hold multiple of community activities on the event day. We have obtained over 100 tickets of “National Security Education Day Carnival 2023” from Kwun Tong District Office at the Auxiliary Police Headquarters in Kowloon Bay. You are encouraged to get tickets during school office hours on 13/4(Thu) and 14/4(Fri). First come, first served. You can also get tickets on the spot in the afternoon on 15/4(Sat).
