## Mid-Autumn Festival Parent-Child Lantern Making Competition



Dear Parents:

Hello! The Mid-Autumn Festival is approaching. To carry on the traditions of Chinese festival culture and art and add to the joyous atmosphere of the Mid-Autumn Festival, our kindergarten will be holding a "Mid-Autumn Festival Parent-Child Lantern Creation Competition." We invite parents to submit a parent-child lantern design for the competition, allowing all teachers, students, and parents to enjoy different styles of lanterns and celebrate the Mid-Autumn Festival together. The competition rules are listed below. We kindly request your attention and participation. For environmental reasons, we will not be printing parent reply slips. Thank you for your understanding! <p>Entries Rules</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Entries must be original and cannot be plagiarized. Modified purchased lanterns are also not permitted.</li> <li>2. The maximum size of an entry is 35cm x 35cm x 35cm. Entries exceeding this size limit will not be accepted.</li> <li>3. Entries must be designed for hanging and therefore must include a rope. The base of the lantern must display a device for placing candles. Since the lantern will be displayed in the exhibition area, batteries and bamboo sticks should be avoided to prevent deformation or the lantern from falling due to excessive weight.</li> <li>4. All submitted lanterns will be displayed in the school corridors for a considerable period. The lanterns may be affected by rain during the exhibition. Entrants are advised to use lightweight, moisture-proof, non-deformable, and colorfast materials to ensure that accessories do not fall off. If an entrant discovers their lantern has been damaged by rain and wishes to repair it, they must first notify the school administration.</li> <li>5. Each child may submit only one entry.</li> </ol>
<p>Scoring Criteria</p>	<p>Total score: 10 points</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The artwork matches the self-selected name, demonstrates exquisite craftsmanship, and has an aesthetically pleasing design: 6 points</li> <li>2. The materials used are creative and environmentally friendly: 4 points</li> </ol>
<p>Awards</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Most Popular with Faculty and Parents Award (Champion, First Runner-up, Second Runner-up) ~ Selected by vote of all faculty, staff, and parents.</li> <li>2. Most Popular with Children Award (Champion, First Runner-up, Second Runner-up) ~ Selected by vote of all children.</li> <li>3. Guest Judge Award ~ Selected by the school's Superintendent, Mr. Kwan Chi-keung, principals of other schools, and representatives of regional organizations. No limit on the number of awards.</li> <li>4. Overall Champion Award (One winner)</li> <li>5. Several Merit Awards</li> </ol>

Submission Date	Please submit your named entries to your child's homeroom teacher between 5:00 PM on September 8 (Monday) and September 19th (Friday). Entries submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.
Rating date	Parents are invited to vote from September 23 (Tuesday) to September 25 (Thursday) before or after school.
Award date	Awards will be presented at the "Enjoying the Splendor of Chinese Culture Together - A Fun-filled Mid-Autumn Festival for Families" event held at our kindergarten on October 3th (Friday). Winners will receive a phone call from the school administration staff before 5:00 PM on September 26th (Friday) to inform them of the award collection arrangements.
Remark	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All entries will be on public display at the school from 22/9((Monday) to 24/10 (Friday). They will then be returned to the children.</li> <li>2. Parents are requested to avoid touching the artworks while viewing them and to vote on the judging day.</li> </ol>
